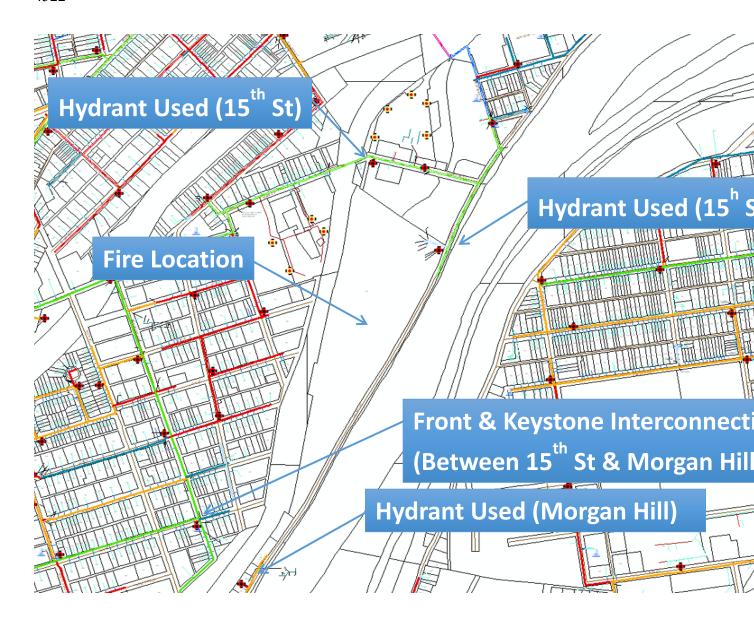

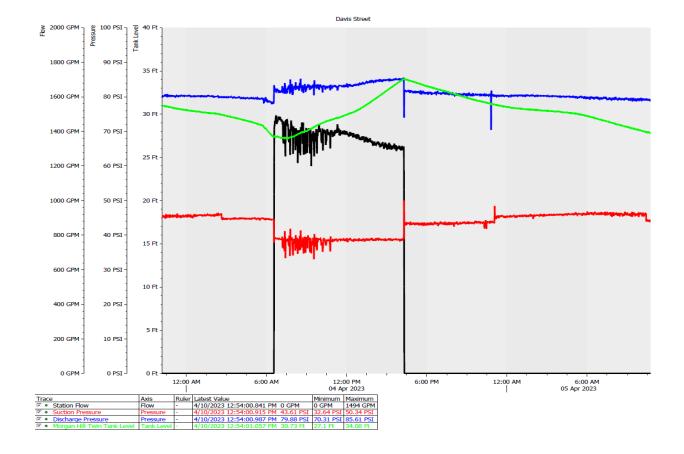

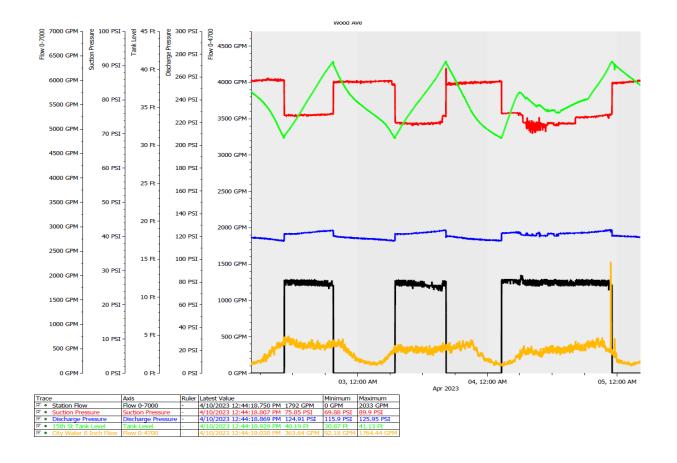
100,000 Twin Reservoir System



Morgan Hill – Scada trend

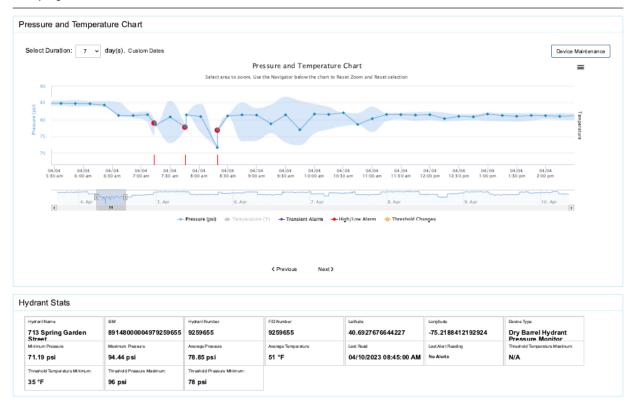


Wood Ave – Scada trends

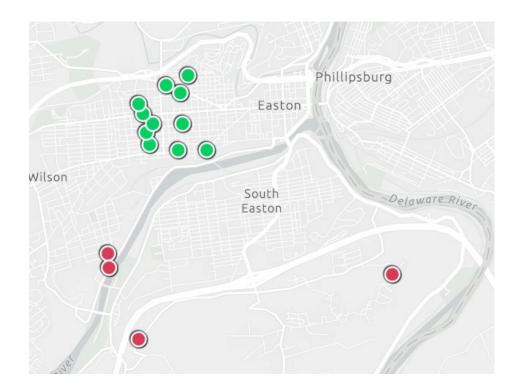


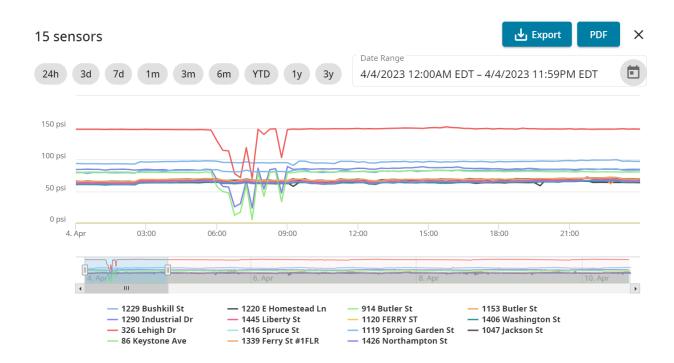
713 Spring Garden – Hydrant Mon

Water Meter Pressure Monitors



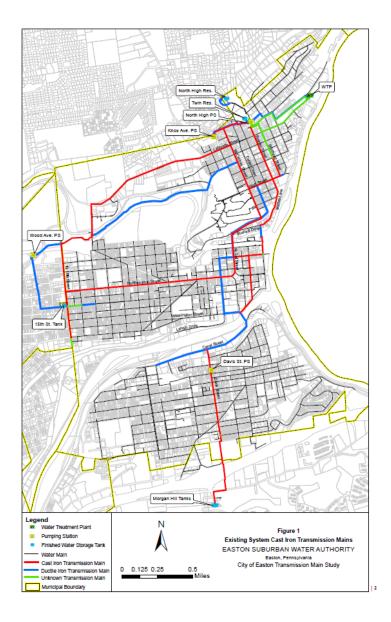


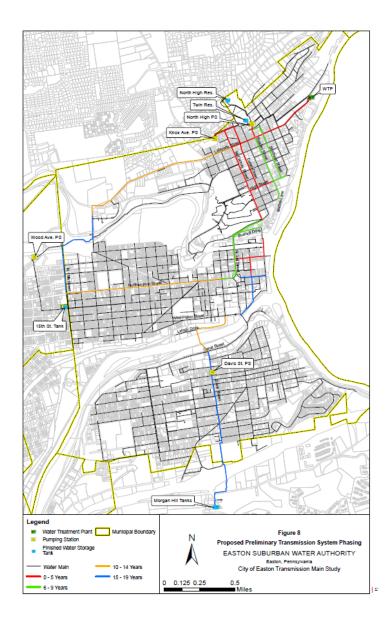
