



Construction Projects

We're always investing in ways to improve our water supply. It's smart to be proactive and head off potential problems before they become bigger issues. We do that by continuously updating or adding needed infrastructure. Here are some of the projects we're tackling in the next few months to ensure safe, reliable water for all:

Bushkill Creek Crossing and Tatamy Road Water System Improvements

Easton Suburban Water Authority is finalizing design and permitting of a project to replace the existing 10" cast iron water main on Tatamy Road between Hackett Avenue and Walter Road in Palmer Township. The project will also include the installation of a new water main crossing the Bushkill Creek near the Bushkill Park Drive Bridge. Design and permitting will be completed in the Spring of 2026, with construction being performed in the Summer and Fall of 2026.

City of Easton Transmission Main Improvements

Easton Suburban Water Authority is in the design phase of a project to replace the existing 24" cast iron water main Lafayette Street in the City of Easton with a new 30" ductile iron water main. The work will be performed on Lafayette Street between North Delaware Drive and the intersection with Reeder Street. Design and permitting is anticipated to be completed in 2026, with construction being performed in 2027.

Paxinosa Tank Painting Project

Easton Suburban Water Authority has completed the design and engineering work for a project to repaint the water storage tank located on Paxinosa Road East in Forks Township. The interior and exterior of the tank will be repainted in the Fall of 2026.

Ensuring The Best Tasting and Smelling Water

As always, we're monitoring for Geosmin and MIB in the Delaware River, our water source. These naturally forming organic compounds can create an earthy taste with a musty smell but pose no health risks. With warmer temperatures, Geosmin and MIB levels tend to increase so we'll closely check the Delaware River as Spring turns to Summer.
